

FACT SHEET 06 FORK LIFT TRUCK OPERATOR TRAINING – RECOGNISED ACCREDITING BODIES

The Health and Safety Commission recognize a number of bodies as being competent to accredit training organisations for the training of fork lift truck instructors and operators. When selecting a trainer or training company it would be prudent to check that they have been accredited by one of these bodies and that the accreditation is current.
